Frequently Asked Questions

Q: What is the difference between the Saturday classes and the in-kennel training?

A: Saturday classes require much more outside work to get your dog to the same level of obedience. In-kennel training is more intense and gives our trainers plenty of time to work with your dog one-on-one to ensure that s/he performs the commands correctly and without question.

Q: If I choose the in-kennel training, can I come visit my dog?

A: Of course! We love to have owners come out and visit their dogs.

Q: How old should my dog be?

A: 4 months to 2 years old is the best window to get your dog trained.

Q: Which breeds should be trained?

A: All breeds can benefit; both big and small!

Q: What method of training is used?

A: Praise training, which means getting petted and praised for what is done correctly. Encouraging the dog's normal instincts and confidence.

What Your Dog Will Learn

- Basic manners, like not jumping up on you or snapping
- Basic to advanced obedience commands: Heel, sit, stay, down, and come, most of these with non-verbal commands
- We also do specialty training such as house breaking and protection training.

Your dog will be happier after the classes knowing what is expected of him or her.

- All obedience classes include basic vocal commands and hand signals.
- Leash training includes training your dog to walk on a leash without pulling.

Whichever program you will choose for your dog, you will be glad you did. You will have your dog for its lifetime; let it be a lifetime of fulfillment!

Our classes are open to all breeds, therefore giving our trainers a wide field of hands on experience.

We have participated in pet therapy for nursing home and rehabilitation centers. As you can imagine in all these programs it is very important that we have animals that are good companions.



Cost

Saturday Morning Obedience Classes (3 months from 10-11am each week) = \$100

2 Week In-Kennel Obedience Training (on leash) = \$600

The In-Kennel training includes free obedience classes afterwards to keep up the training, or just to have fun with your dog and other dog people.

1 Week Advanced Obedience Training (off-leash) = \$300

All of these include basic manners!
